
#### NEW SUNDAY MASS SCHEDULE

To celebrate the Solemnity of Christ the King this year, there will be 40 Hours Adoration in the Cathedral, beginning with Mass at 7.30pm on Friday 22nd November and concluding with Solemn Vespers and Benediction at 4pm on Sunday 24th November to which all are welcome. Our Parish has been allocated the time of 9am on Saturday 23rd November. As part of the 40 Hours Devotion, Confessions will be heard in the Cathedral continually from 12 noon to 12 midnight on Saturday 23rd November. While each parish of the diocese will be assigned to a particular hour of adoration, people are in no way restricted to their parish's hour. It is hoped that people from the Diocese will come to the Cathedral during this time to pray.
